

Bill	Substance	Council Reaction
HB032	Local law enforcement vehicles having AEDs (automated external defibrillators)	Noting the expense (which Salmerón estimated at \$2,500 per unit) Pompi suggested monitoring the bill and maybe requesting an amendment, for example AEDs in only one vehicle per shift.
HB035	Local governments' power to regulate the invasive Tree of Heaven plant	Greenbelt might provide useful supporting testimony given long experience in controlling invasive plants.
HB0071	Medical assistance, psychiatric/youth rehabilitation	Worth monitoring and supporting, given Greenbelt's priority of youth mental health
HB0079	Climate solutions affordability	Might provide funding for energy-efficient upgrades
HB0085	Housing associations, corporations and cooperatives	More information is needed about impact on Greenbelt.
HB0092	Restricting sale of beverage containers with plastic rings	"That's something we have a lot of passion about in Greenbelt," Pompi said, advising support.
HB0099	Land use and density	City administration supports this legislation giving land use authority to municipalities, Salmerón noted, "as we want for our city."
HB0104	Affirmative defense for unhoused individuals	Worth monitoring for congruence with Greenbelt's policies
HB0153	Air conditioning in rental apartments	Worth monitoring given heat problems in Greenbelt
HB0155	Law enforcement face coverings	This active bill is worth monitoring.
HB0167	Restricting gas-powered leaf blowers	Worth monitoring because Greenbelt would need funding to financially assist owners required to replace such machines
HB0168	Affordable housing for the educator workforce	Worth monitoring
HB0172	Body-worn cameras for municipal enforcement officers	Worth monitoring whether guidelines conflict with Greenbelt's existing body camera requirements
HB0197	Community safety funding	Public and youth safety being a priority in Greenbelt, the city should advocate for municipal (not just county) access to any available funding.
HB0224	Support for those returning from incarceration	Monitor for availability of local funding.
HB0239	Starter and silver housing	Greenbelt does not control zoning, but impactful requirements such as setbacks and lot size should be monitored.
HB0331	Beverage container refund and litter reduction ("Bottle Bill")	Council recently voted in support.

HB0345	Pertaining to public utility solar generating systems and renewable energy credits	Greenbelt has many existing solar installations, so monitor for impact.
HB0350	Voting rights for county and municipal elections	Directly affects local elections so more information is needed
HB0352	Unmasking of federal agents	Monitor for whether this impacts Greenbelt.
HB0357	Municipal election dates and reporting requirements	Directly affects local elections so more information is needed
HB0368	Supplementary homeowner tax credit	Could provide tax relief for residents
HB405	Condominium or homeowners association electrical vehicle charging equipment	Worth monitoring
HB0235	Neighborhood Business Development Program	Councilmember Danielle McKinney observed, “We’re trying to increase assistance for businesses in our community.”
HB0240	Planning guidance and notifications	Pending input from Planning on the bill, McKinney speculated that it might “aid communication and coordination between the state planning agencies and our municipality.”
HB0709	Good-cause evictions	Worth monitoring. This is a Greenbelt priority.
HB0107	Speed monitoring	See body of article.
HB0256	Speed safety corridors	Salmerón referenced certain stretches of road such as Kenilworth Avenue where speed monitoring could provide safety benefits.
HB0353	Termination of gas and electricity in multi-family units	Situation has occurred in Greenbelt.
HB0369	Property tax credit for new businesses	Proposed by local Delegate Ashanti Martinez
HB0394	County sidewalks, crosswalks and safe routes to school	Worth monitoring due to maintenance issues with the State Highway Administration
HB0402	Common ownership communities needing databases and other governance requirements	Worth monitoring for impact
